20. There are 227 tins of milk powder in the shop. If 144 tins of milk powder are sold, how many tins of milk powder are left?

Answer: 83 tins of milk powder are left.



21. This year is a leap year and 219 days have passed. How many days are left?

Answer: 147 days are left.

Analysis (Q20)

Number of tins of milk powder left is:
 $227 - 144 = 83$ (tins)

Analysis (Q21)

Number of days left is:
 $366 - 219 = 147$ (days)

22. There are 438 people on the train. If 156 people get off the train, how many people are left on the train?

Answer: 282 people are left on the train.

Analysis (Q22)

Number of people left is:
 $438 - 156 = 282$ (people)

23. Samuel has 246 stamps. Kelly has 118 fewer stamps than Samuel. How many stamps does Kelly have? (Show your working)

Kelly has:
 $246 - 118$
 $= 128$ (stamps)

24. A roll of ribbon is 374 cm long. After cutting off 169 cm of ribbon, how many centimetres of ribbon are left? (Show your working)

Length of ribbon left is:
 $374 - 169$
 $= 205$ (centimetres)
