**Analysis (Q19)**  
Amy is taller than Betty by:  
 $114 - 89 = 25$  (cm)

**Analysis (Q20)**  
It is cheaper by:  
 $205 - 178 = \$27$

21. Mandy wants to buy a music box which costs \$222, but she only has \$156. How much more does she need?

Answer: She needs \$ 66 more.

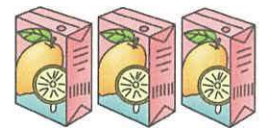
**Analysis (Q21)**  
She needs:  
 $222 - 156 = \$66$



22. There are 363 boxes of lemon tea in the supermarket. If 195 boxes of lemon tea are sold, how many boxes of lemon tea are left?

Answer: 168 boxes of lemon tea are left.

**Analysis (Q22)**  
Number of boxes of lemon tea left is:  
 $363 - 195 = 168$  (boxes)



23. Miss Poon has 239 pieces of blue paper and 438 pieces of yellow paper. How many more pieces of yellow paper than blue paper does she have?

Answer: She has 199 more pieces of yellow paper than blue paper.

24. A dictionary costs \$383. If Mr Lee pays \$500 to buy the dictionary, how much change should he get? (Show your working)

He should get:  
 $500 - 383$   
 $= \$117$

**Analysis (Q23)**  
She has:  
 $438 - 239 = 199$  (pieces)

25. There are 641 books on the bookshelves. After 274 books are taken away, how many books are left? (Show your working)

Number of books left is:  
 $641 - 274$   
 $= 367$  (books)
