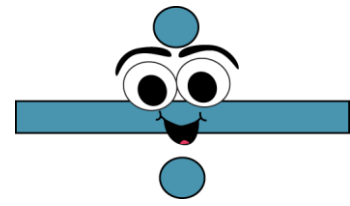


Q1 Fill in the blanks

Total: 4 marks



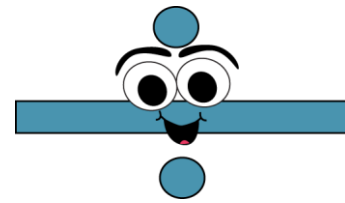
Q2. Do these sums

Total: 2 marks

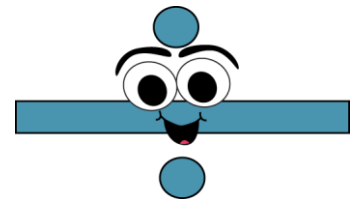


Q3.

4 children share 28 apples equally.
How many apples does each child
get?

- a) 6 apples

$$28 \div 4 = 7$$



Q4.

Each box can hold 10 eggs. Pack all 37 eggs into the boxes. At least how many boxes are needed?

a) 7 boxes

$$37 \div 10$$

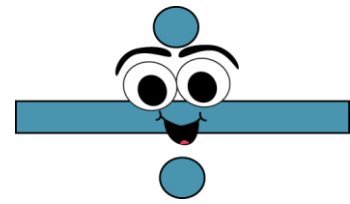
b) 3 boxes

$$= 3 \text{ boxes} \dots 7 \text{ eggs}$$

c) 4 boxes

1 extra box for the last 7 eggs

$$3 + 1 = 4 \text{ boxes}$$



Q5.

Mr Chan has \$68. Each pen costs \$9.
How many pens can he buy at most?

a) 5 pens

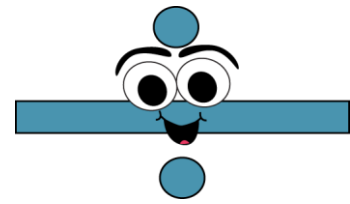
b) 7 pens

c) 8 pens

$$68 \div 9 = 7 \text{ pens} \dots \$5$$

The \$5 left is NOT enough for one more pen.

Q6.



Each bottle of juice costs \$6.

3 children share the juice.

They pay \$48 in total.

How many bottles of juice do they buy?

a) $6 \div 3$

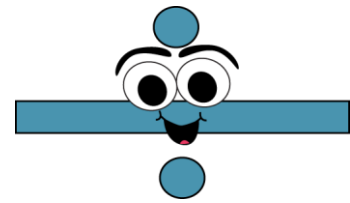
b) $48 \div 3$

d) $48 \div 6 \div 3$



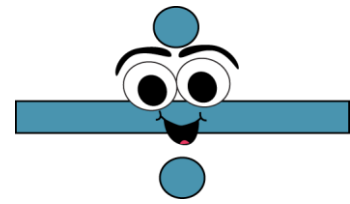
Q7.

Q8.



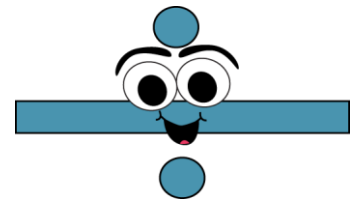
Each bookmark costs \$4. Mrs Wong buys 24 bookmarks. How much should she pay?
