Past Simple (Irregular verbs)

• Irregular verbs are verbs that do not take on the regular endings -d, -ed or -ied spelling pattern of the past simple. They change in other ways.

E.a.

Present	go	sing	sleep	drink
Past	went	sang	slept	drank

- Some irregular verbs do not change in spelling, e.g. the past simple of read is read. The spelling is the same but the pronunciation is different.
- Other irregular verbs, e.g. cut, hit and beat do not change in spelling or pronunciation.
